- Keep facilities, machinery, and equipment in safe, operational condition through preventative, predictive, and corrective maintenance;
- Conduct routine inspections of facility building, grounds and equipment to prevent failures and check safety systems;
- Key tasks include diagnosing problems, fixing plumbing/electrical systems, conducting repairs, and performing facility upkeep;
- Complies with all company safety regulations and maintains an efficient and safe working environment for all employees;
- Ensure compliance to all state and federal regulations and design appropriate plant maintenance programs to reduce all downtime;
- Keeps a maintenance log and writes shift reports.
